

The following is the list of changes to the January 2017 Denver Metro Protocols:

1. 0100 Mandatory Reporting – Additional information regarding “at-risk adults” added
2. 1020 Percutaneous Cricothyrotomy – Purple box deleted and information regarding age moved to contraindications.
3. 0140 Pediatric Needle Cricothyrotomy – Picture of recommended kit configuration added. Language regarding medical director discretion in use of protocol.
4. 1110 Intraosseous Catheter Placement – Language change to indication.
5. 2020 Pediatric Respiratory Distress – CPAP removed from this protocol.
6. 2040 Pediatric Wheezing – CPAP removed from this protocol.
7. 2050 Pediatric Stridor/Croup – Change in algorithm configuration and “racemic epinephrine” changed to “nebulized epinephrine”.
8. 3000 Universal Pulseless Arrest and 3010 Universal Pulseless Arrest Considerations – All references to cycles changed to minutes.
9. 3070 Cardiac Alert – Language added on IV insertion locations
10. 4000 Medical Hypotension – Change to language regarding pediatric fluid bolus dosing.
11. 4030 Stroke – “Cincinnati Prehospital Stroke Score” changed to “Cincinnati Prehospital Stroke Scale”.
12. 4070 Alcohol Intoxication – Changed to “Drug/Alcohol Intoxication”.
13. 8040 Traumatic Shock – Change to language regarding pediatric fluid bolus dosing.
14. 8090 Spinal Precautions – Change to language in gray box regarding cervical collar and penetrating trauma.
15. 9010 Adenosine – Change to pediatric maximum dosing.
16. 9060 Atropine – Change to **Description**
17. 9090 Dextrose – Change to pediatric dosing
18. 9120 Epinephrine – Fluid amount added to alternative dosing.
19. 9210 Naloxone – Language regarding bystander administration and patient refusal.
20. 9220 Nitroglycerin – “or spray” removed from **Dosage and Administration**.
