

The following is the list of protocol items for the July 2017 Denver Metro Protocols:

1. Throughout protocol is some places where ETCO₂ is mentioned for monitoring, it has been changed to “waveform capnography”.
2. 0110 FSED – Change to language regarding FSED as ambulance destinations.
3. 0990 Quick Reference Guide – Updated to include base contact for pacing pediatric patients and epinephrine administration during cardiac arrest to standing order for Intermediates.
4. 1090 Synchronized Cardioversion – First gray information box removed and sedation with benzodiazepine language changed.
5. 1100 Transcutaneous Cardiac Pacing – Base contact added for pediatric patients
6. 3000 Universal Pulseless Arrest Algorithm – Gray box added about mechanical CPR devices.
7. 3040 Tachycardia with Poor Perfusion – Pediatric specific guidelines added.
8. 3050 Bradycardia with Poor Perfusion – Pediatric specific guidelines added.
9. 3020 Neonatal Resuscitation – Additional language and guidance on when to administer oxygen.
10. 3090 Ventricular Assist Devices – New protocol added.
11. 4000 Medical Shock – Language regarding length based tape and pull/push guidelines corrected.
12. 4050 Hypoglycemia – Gray box added regarding considerations for hyperglycemia.
13. 8040 Traumatic Shock - Language regarding length based tape and pull/push guidelines corrected.
14. 9010 Adenosine – Guidance on pediatric and AVRNT added.
15. 9030 Amiodarone – Updated to match 0990 Quick Reference Guide.
16. 9090 Dextrose – Language regarding dilution for children 1-8 years old removed.
17. 9150 Hemostatic Agent – Change to follow manufacturer specific guidelines for specific agents.
18. 9210 Naloxone – Guidance on potential need for higher doses added.
19. 9230 Opioids – Change in fentanyl intranasal guidelines, dosing, and maximum dose for pediatric patients.
20. Appendix A – The Foothills and Mile-High RETAC Trauma Triage Algorithms have been added to the protocols.
