

January 2018 Denver Metro Protocol List of Changes:

1. 0050 Termination of Resuscitation – Change to medical pulseless arrest sections regarding end-points to termination.
2. 0070 Patient Determination – Addition of vital sign time parameters
3. 0130 Transportation of the Pediatric Patient – Guidance added on obtaining blood pressure in pediatric patients
4. 0990 Quick Reference – Updated to match protocol changes
5. 3080 Hypertension – Addition of acquire 12 lead to protocol
6. 3090 LVAD – Change of flow for VAD Running box and addition of Children’s Hospital contact information
7. 4010 Altered Mental Status – Addition of acquire 12 lead to protocol
8. 4030 Stroke – Addition of acquire 12 lead to protocol
9. 5000 Drowning – Single attempt clarified for AED and manual defibrillation if patient is hypothermic
10. 5010 Hypothermia – Single attempt clarified for AED and manual defibrillation
11. 8000 General Trauma Care – Inclusion of hemostatic agent in exsanguinating hemorrhage
12. 8030 Traumatic Pulseless Arrest – Inclusion of items from 8000 General Trauma Care
13. 8040 Traumatic Shock – Inclusion of items from 8000 General Trauma Care
14. 9000 Medication Administration Guidelines – Addition of vital sign parameters
15. 9040 Antiemetics – Promethazine adult dose change and pediatric dose removed from protocol
16. 9100 Benadryl – Removal of age range and change to pediatric dosing.
17. 9140 Haloperidol – Change to pediatric dosing
18. 9160 Hydroxocobalamin – Addition of dosing chart and removal of 2.5 g mixing instructions
19. 9180 Lidocaine – Gray box to lidocaine protocol about viscous lidocaine added
