- 3. 0020 General Guideline: 911 System Response to Request for Interfacility Transport New protocol to provide guidance when responding to a 911 request at a healthcare facility (e.g. free-standing emergency department)
- 4. 0170 Procedure Protocol: Transcutaneous Cardiac Pacing Initial current changed from 40 mAmps to 80 mAmps
- 5. 0180 Procedure Protocol: Therapeutic Induced Hypothermia After Cardiac Arrest Protocol has been removed
- 6. 2025 Post-Resuscitation Care with ROSC Updated to include information about targeted temperature management (TTM) and directs treatment of hypotension to the 4060 Medical Hypotension/Shock protocol
- 7. 5090 Burns Swedish Medical Center added as a regional burn center for any age patient, voice changes/hoarseness added as critical signs to look for, emphasized consideration of CO poisoning, and added volume suggestion in addition to rate for fluid resuscitation.
- 8. 7010 Calcium Gluconate protocol changed to 7010 Calcium allowing for administration of calcium gluconate or calcium chloride.
- 9. 7010 Dextrose dose for < 1 year changed to 5-10 mL/kg of a 10% solution from 2-4 mL/kg.
- 10.7010 Antiemetic No change to Zofran contraindications
- 11.7010 Hemostatic Agent New protocol
- 12.7010 Opioids Shivering changed to targeted temperature management (TTM)
